FOUNDER'S DAY

On Friday, April 22, 1938, there will occur the thirteenth annual celebration in honor of William W. Cook, the Founder of the Law Quadrangle at the University of Michigan. The Honorable Orie L. Phillips of the United States Circuit Court of Appeals will be the guest of honor of the occasion. The principal event of the day will be a dinner, which will be held at the Lawyers Club at 6:30 o'clock, at which Judge Phillips will speak.

At two o'clock in the afternoon there will be held the annual student inter-case-club contest, at the conclusion of which the Henry M. Campbell award will be made. A group of four second-year students consisting of Messrs. Clifford C. Christenson, Ralph E. Helper, Robert C. Keck and Bruce M. Smith, who have shown the greatest proficiency in the regular work of the second-year case clubs during the current year, will argue a moot case before a bench of distinguished judges who have been invited for the occasion. This contest, which will be held in Hutchins Hall, is open to the public.
