S. B. A. ELECTIONS WILL BE HELD APRIL 23rd to fill the position of President, Vice-President, and Secretary/Treasurer. Elections for Junior and Senior Class Presidents will also be held on that day. Petitions must be submitted before 9 P.M. April 20 to Lou Kwiker in the Law Club and should include a brief biographical statement and a photograph. All members of the student body are eligible to vote for SBA officers, but only class members may vote for their respective presidents.

THE LAW SCHOOL WILL BE THE HOST FOR THE ALSA 6TH CIRCUIT CONVENTION THIS FRIDAY AND SATURDAY. The theme of the Convention is "Integration as a Legal and Social Problem." Professor Harvey and a representative of the NAACP will address the delegates. The gathering will conclude with a banquet Saturday night at the Union with Professor Kimball as the featured speaker.

THE FINALS OF THE CAMPBELL COMPETITION WILL TAKE PLACE THIS FRIDAY AT 2:30 IN ROOM 100, HUTCHINS HALL.
