THIRD SERIES OF THOMAS M. COOLEY LECTURES

The third series of Thomas M. Cooley Lectures will be given by Professor Zechariah Chafee, Jr., Langdell Professor of Law of Harvard University, on April 18 to 22, inclusive, at 4:15 P.M. in Room 120 of Hutchins Hall, the University of Michigan. The first series of Cooley Lectures was given by Professor Henry Rottschaefer of the University of Minnesota, and the second series by Professor Burke Shartel of the University of Michigan.

Professor Chafee's subject is "Some Problems of Equity." The titles of the individual lectures are as follows:

- I Going Into Equity with Unclean Hands.
- II Representative Suits—(1)
- III Representative Suits—(2), With Special Reference to Federal Rule 23.
- IV Lack of Power and Mistaken Use of Power.
- V How Far Does Equity Follow the Law, and Whither?

Professor Chafee is one of the leading experts on the subject of equity in this country. He has written extensively on that field of law and also on many other legal questions. He is the co-author of a casebook on equity and is also the author of a casebook on equitable remedies. Among his writings are *Freedom of Speech* (1920), *The Inquiring Mind* (1928), *Free Speech in the United States* (1941), *Government and Mass Communications* (1947). He is a member of the United Nations Sub-Commission on Freedom of Information and was a member of the United States delegation to the United Nations conference on Freedom of Information at Geneva in 1948.

Professor Chafee's lectures are open to the public. A special invitation is extended to members of the bar.
