

## PART V. LAW OF DISCOVERY

### Article 517. Rights of a discoverer

A discoverer has the right to demand recognition as a discoverer and priority of discovery, certified by a diploma, which is issued in those cases and in the manner provided by the Statute on Discoveries, Inventions and Rationalization Proposals approved by the Council of Ministers of the USSR.

A discoverer has a right to remuneration, payable to him upon receipt of his diploma, as well as to the benefits specified in the Statute on Discoveries, Inventions and Rationalization Proposals.

### Article 518. Transfer by inheritance of the rights of a discoverer

The right of a deceased discoverer to receive a diploma and remuneration for his discovery passes by inheritance in the manner prescribed by law.

### Article 519. Disputes over a discovery

Disputes over a discovery (co-discovery) are decided by a court.
