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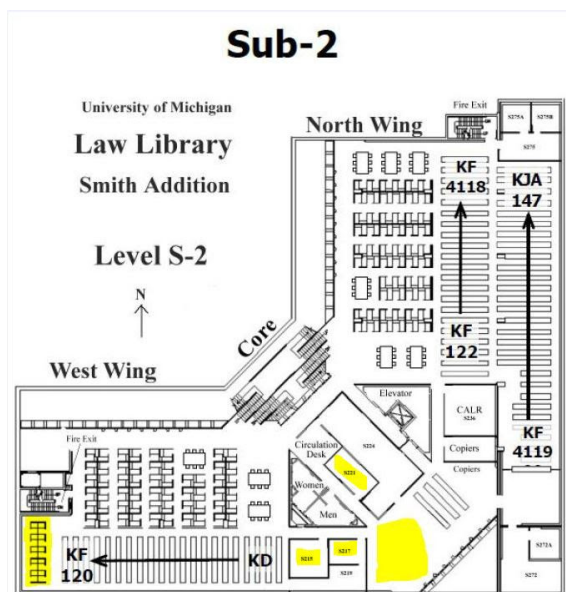
## INCREASE IN ID CHECKS

Please remember to bring your MCards when planning to study in the Reading Room, Commons, or underground library. If you leave your MCards on the table where you're studying in the Reading Room or Commons, the Reading Room Desk assistants will be able to perform ID checks without interrupting you.

The Reading Room Desk assistants have begun more frequent ID and printer checks in the Commons and Reading Room for the final exam period. If you notice non-law students in restricted study spaces, you can ask the Reading Room Desk assistants to do an ID check at any time.

## QUIET STUDY SPACES

With exams approaching, we know that many of you are in search of quiet study spaces. Did you know that some of the quietest study spaces in the Law School are located in the subs? Two featured spaces are in the sub-2 core behind the Circulation Desk area, and on the far end of the West Wing of sub-2. There are also three group study rooms on sub-2; the rooms are S-221, S-217, and S-215.
